Offense: Burglary of a Conveyance

Synopsis: The University of South Florida Police Department (USFPD) received notification of a vehicle burglary that occurred at Riverfront Park on February 22, 2020, between 11:30 a.m. and 12:10 p.m.

The unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the unlocked vehicle and then once inside the suspect(s) removed personal items. The suspect(s) then went to a local merchant and used the victim's credit card.
