COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

On Sunday July 8, 2018, at approximately 8:18 p.m., the University of South Florida Police Department received notification of a white male subject who had exposed himself on the Northeast side of Juniper-Poplar Hall.

The USF Police initiated an investigation and searched the area, however, were unable to find the suspect. The suspect is described as a white male, with glasses, 30-40 years of age, dark brown balding hair and a beard, wearing a blue shirt and dark blue shorts. This is an active criminal investigation.
