Ashok Kumar, professor in the Department of Mechanical Engineering has been elected a Fellow of the American Institute for Medical and Biological Engineering (AIMBE). He received this award for 'Contributions to the development of nanotechnology-based thin film biomaterials for multifunctional applications and untiring service to broader materials community'. Kumar will be formally inducted at the AIMBE Annual Event on March 15-17, 2015, at the National Academy of Sciences in Washington, D.C.

Fellows are nominated each year by their peers and represent the top two percent of the medical and biological engineering community. Election to AIMBE is a multi-step process with extensive peer review followed by a vote by all current fellows. The College of Fellows consists of over 1,500 individuals who are the outstanding leaders, engineers, entrepreneurs, and innovators in medical and biological engineering.
