TITLE: Basic Guidelines to Follow While Working Within Animal

Rooms

SCOPE: All Authorized Personnel

RESPONSIBILITY: Facility Manager, and Technical Personnel

PURPOSE: To outline the general guideline for the performance of

animal care activities while in animal rooms and support

areas.

I. PROCEDURES

- A) Determine the work to be accomplished within animal rooms or support areas by reviewing area work schedule, or consultation with area supervisory personnel.
- B) Avoid unnecessary noise and activity while working in animal room.
- C) Daily cage checks are to be performed as early in the workday as practical. Facility and Health Concerns are to be reported in writing to the manager.
- D) Complete Daily Room Status Sheets when duties have been completed.
- E) Animals are to always be handled and treated humanely, in a fashion which prevents stress, injury and harm.
- F) Extreme care will be taken to prevent mixing of animals and to maintain correct cage configuration.
- G) Replace animal and cage to the same rack and location during change out.
- H) Animal rooms and support areas will be maintained in as neat and orderly fashion as possible throughout the day.
